

Supplement To
Flood Prevention
Operation and Maintenance Agreement
Nine Mile Creek Watershed

Made and entered into on February 19, 1959, by and between the Soil Conservation Service, United States Department of Agriculture and the Upper Washita Soil and Water Conservation District.

Add Sites 12 through 18, Seven (7) floodwater retarding structures.

Amend paragraph IV as follows:

Annual maintenance cost of the 18 floodwater retarding structures, is estimated to be \$1,751.00.

All other conditions of the original agreement remain the same.
