

Supplement To
Flood Prevention
Operation and Maintenance Agreement
Upper Washita Watershed

Made and entered into on February 19, 1959, by and between the Soil Conservation Service, United States Department of Agriculture and the Upper Washita Soil and Water Conservation District.

Add Sites 59 through 65 and Grade Stabilization Structure 101.

Amend paragraph IV as follows:

Annual maintenance cost of the 31 floodwater retarding structures and 1 grade stabilization structure, is estimated to be \$3,473.00.

All other conditions of the original agreement remain the same.
