A G R E E M E N T

RELATIVE TO: Site 22, Big Nowaka Creek Watershed.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 3rd day of May, 1965, by and between the Department of Wildlife Conservation, State of Oklahoma, Successor to the Oklahoma Game and Fish Department, (hereinafter referred to as "State"), and the Seminole County Soil And Water Conservation District, Hughes County Soil And Water Conservation District, Shawnee Soil And Water Conservation District, and Nowaka Creek Soil And Water Conservation District No. 2, (hereinafter referred to as the "Sponsoring Local Organizations"), and the United States Department of Agriculture Soil Conservation Service, (hereinafter referred to as the "Service"):

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of April, 1957, the State entered into an agreement with the Sponsoring Local Organizations, whereby the State agreed to participate in the operation and maintenance of the dam and appurtenances on the above described Site 22 in accordance with the provisions expressed in said agreement and

WHEREAS, the City of Seminole, Oklahoma, is purchasing the vested rights of the State in and to Site 22 and

WHEREAS, On the 3rd day of May, 1965, the Service, Sponsoring Local Organizations and the City of Seminole, Oklahoma, executed an Agreement and an Operation and Maintenance Agreement on Site 22, wherein the City of Seminole, Oklahoma agreed to operate and maintain said site and the Service and Sponsoring Local Organizations agreed and accepted said agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants herein contained, and expressed in the aforementioned Agreement and Operation and Maintenance Agreement, dated May 3, 1965, the parties hereto agree as follows:

I. The Sponsoring Local Organizations agree:

That the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Department is expressly released from any and all of its obligations and responsibilities for the operation and maintenance of Site 22, which were set forth in the above described agreement dated April 3, 1957.

II. The Service agrees:

That the Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Department is expressly released from any and all of its obligations and responsibilities for the operation and maintenance of Site 22, which were set forth in the above described agreement dated April 3, 1957.

III. The State agrees:

And accepts its being released from the obligations or responsibilities expressed in the above described agreement dated April 3, 1957, in regard to the operation and maintenance of Site 22.

IV. IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED:

That the provisions expressed in this agreement become effective when the State's vested rights in Site 22 are transferred to the City of Seminole.
